### **"Charter Challenges and Judicial Review: Grandstanding or Groundbreaking?"**



#### **JANET E. MINOR, LL.B., LL.M., MINISTRY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, CONSTITUTIONAL LAW BRANCH**

Janet E. Minor is General Counsel in the Constitutional Law Branch of Ontario's Ministry of the Attorney General. Called to the Bar in 1975 she has an LL.B. from the University of Toronto and an LL.M. from Osgoode Hall Law School. After two years of general litigation at the firm of Manning, Bruce, she joined the Ministry of the Attorney General in 1977. She has worked in public law since that time: first at the Crown Law Office Civil and since 1989, in the Constitutional Law Branch. A highly respected advocate, she appears before all levels of Court and has argued many significant cases on behalf of the Ontario government. Ms. Minor is a member of a number of professional organizations and is a past Director of the Advocates' Society, past Chair of the Sir William Campbell Foundation and past Executive Member of the Constitutional Law Section of the OBA. She is a founding member and former Director of the Association of Law Officers of the Crown. Ms. Minor was a Bencher of the LSUC from 2001-2003, serving on the Professional Development & Competence and Equity Committees. She currently sits on the University Tribunal and Discipline Appeals Board at the University of Toronto. Ms. Minor is a speaker and lecturer at numerous educational programs for the Ministry, Bar and public. Since 2004, she has taught Administrative Law as an adjunct professor at Osgoode Hall Law School. Ms. Minor received the 2003 President's Award for the Women's Law Association of Ontario.

Peter Griffin is a senior partner at Lenczner Slaght. Mr. Griffin's civil litigation practice focuses on commercial disputes, insolvency litigation, audit and accounting issues and professional liability matters. Mr. Griffin graduated from Queen's University with an LL.B. in 1977. He was admitted to the Ontario Bar in 1980. Mr. Griffin's broad experience and involvement in the caes of the day have led to his extensive participation at law schools and continuing education programmes throughout the Province. Mr. Griffin is currently a member of the Executive of The Advocates Society. He is a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers.



#### **SCOTT HUTCHISON, LL.B., STOCKWOODS LLP**

Scott Hutchison's practice includes civil, regulatory and criminal litigation, with a particular interest in white collar crime and appellate advocacy. His recent practice has included civil actions and injunction proceedings (including Anton Piller and Norwich Pharmacal orders), Charter of Rights appeals, an Ontario Securities Commission proceedings. From 1989 to 2005, Mr. Hutchison was counsel at the Crown Law Office (Ontario) where he represented the Crown in all levels of court, including hundreds of appearances in the Court of Appeal and numerous appeals in the Supreme Court of Canada. He is the author of a number of legal texts, including Search and Seizure Law in Canada (Carswell); Hutchison's Search Warrant Manual, 2007 (Carswell); Computer Crime in Canada (with Robert Davis) and is one of the authors of McWilliams Canadian Criminal Evidence (4th Edition) (Canada Law Book). Mr. Hutchison was called to the Bar in 1989 after serving his articles of clerkship with the Ontario Court of Appeal.
